ODFW Extends Deadline to Report 2018 Hunting Results

The deadline to report big game and turkey tags has been extended from January 31 to April 15, 2019 in order to allow users to get used to the new licensing system that was recently put in place. Anyone who purchased one of these tags is required to report regardless of the outcome of the hunt. If you do not report, you will have to pay a \$25 fee upon purchasing tags in 2020. 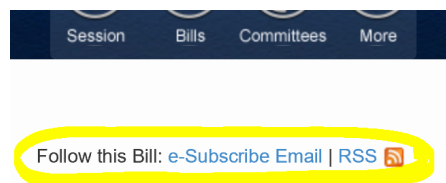
